#### **INTRODUCTION TO WSVRHA CUTTING CLINIC – TRAPPER ROGERS AND BOB GRANT**

The clinic will consist of 3 hours of in depth discussion and instruction about herd entry, driving a cow from the herd, rules, penalties and strategies. We have a strict limit of 10 riders per each ½ day (9am-12pm and 1pm-4pm). While Trapper is instructing the cutters, Bob is going to coach and teach strategy and rules to the turn back and corner help.

We are ordering plenty of extra cattle for this clinic to facilitate LOTS of riding time on cattle, **due to the cost of cattle the fees must be prepaid**, no refund after Wednesday February 25<sup>th</sup>. First 20 paid entries received will be able to ride. We will maintain a waiting list so be sure to send your entries in.

#### **RANCH REIN WORK AND RANCH COW WORK – KEVIN STALLINGS**

Kevin will share his expertise to teach reining maneuvers, go over the pattern and help you with problems you may be having. He will also have cattle available to give instruction on boxing, the new intermediated cow work and fence work. The Cow Horse Clinic is limited to the first 24 paid riders.

#### **RANCH TRAIL AND RANCH RIDING – JUDGE WILL BE SARAH CLIFFORD**

The Trail elements will be set up in a natural area of the park for participants of the Cutting and Cow Horse clinic to have the opportunity to practice in your spare time. Other riders that are not participating in one of the paid clinics have the opportunity to get on the Trail elements with a minimal fee of \$10.00 (to help support AzVRHA).
